



## It's Time for CampBUILD: Carpenter Helper!

Your Girl Scout or troop is confirmed to attend **CampBUILD: Carpenter Helper** on **August 10**, 9am-4pm at Madison College – Commercial Ave Campus. Check in is 8:45-9:00am.

Carpenter helpers are ready to put their design skills into action. Draw out your idea and make it real in the shop. Campers will design, build, and paint a birdhouse while working with experienced tradeswomen to learn the process. In the carpentry shop, girls will discover their creative talents while also learning how to swing a hammer with power and confidence.

### CampBUILD: Carpenter Helper Packing List:

- A sack lunch.
- Girls must wear long pants\* and closed-toe shoes. (*Jeans and a cotton t-shirt is recommended. No leggings.*)
- Water Bottle.
- Sunscreen.
- Sweatshirt or long sleeve shirt (in case an extra layer is needed.)
- Girls with long hair should wear their hair tied back in a ponytail or braids.

*\*We will be doing beginner welding activities. Synthetic fabrics will melt when struck with sparks. Natural Fibers are best.*

- Adults are not required to stay at this event.
- Each girl will need to complete a basic health profile at [CampDoc.com](http://CampDoc.com). You received a link to this site upon registration. Please complete this information by July 15<sup>th</sup> in order for us to properly prepare for the session.
