



It's Time for CampBUILD: Material Handler!

Your Girl Scout or troop is confirmed to attend **CampBUILD: Material Handler** on **August 17**, 8am-12pm at Madison College – Commercial Ave Campus. Check in is 7:45-8:00am. For Girl Scouts attending with their troop, one adult from the troop can check-in the full troop.

Girls will become a master material handler. She will learn the safe use of basic hand tools in the shop while building a simple birdhouse. She'll put design skills to work drawing out a creation, and then she'll work side by side with women who work in carpentry to try new skills and gain confidence in the shop.

CampBUILD: Material Handler Packing List:

- Girls AND Adults must wear long pants* and closed-toe shoes. (*Jeans and a cotton t-shirt is recommended. No leggings.*)
- Water Bottle.
- Sunscreen.
- Sweatshirt or long sleeve shirt (in case an extra layer is needed.)
- Girls with long hair should wear their hair tied back in a ponytail or braids.

**We will be doing beginner welding activities. Synthetic fabrics will melt when struck with sparks. Natural fibers are best.*

Notes:

- All girls must attend this event with an adult. That adult may be a troop leader, or another trusted adult (parent, guardian, aunt, adult sibling, grandparent, etc.) If attending with a troop leader, they must fulfill [Girl Scout Safety Ratios](#) with the appropriate number of registered Girl Scout adults holding a current background check.
- Each girl and adult will need to complete a basic health profile at [CampDoc.com](#). You received a link to this site upon registration. Please complete this information by July 15th in order for us to properly prepare for the session.
