## Volunteer Opportunities

### Day Camp Aide

- Must have completed the program aide training
- **(You must register and pay \$25 camp fee)**

\*Volunteers do not need to do their own planning. Units are all done for you. If you volunteer in crafts, nature or games things are ready for you. You just need to oversee the girls. Please volunteer.

### Transportation

You are responsible for getting to and from the day camp.

## What to Bring to Day Camp every day:

- Net bag with cup, plate, bowl, and silverware *EVERY* day.
- A mask and a spare mask
- Jeans and light weight long sleeve shirt for hiking.
- Bandana
- Rain Gear
- A piece of plastic or something to sit on to stay dry when sitting on the ground.
- Water bottle, sun screen, mosquito repellent.
- Any medications in the original container with instructions (these should be left with day camp director).
- No Sandals allowed at Day Camp, closed-toe shoes ONLY.
