GSUSA Awards

GSUSA Awards are the highest Adult Awards that can be earning in Girl Scouting.

The criteria is set by GSUSA and are award for service that is above and beyond the expected position of a volunteer and no other award would be appropriate.

<p style="text-align: center;">Volunteer of Excellence</p> <p>This award recognizes volunteers who have contributed outstanding service while partnering directly with girls to implement the Girl Scout Leadership Experience through use of the National Program Portfolio (Journey's and the Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting) OR who have worked behind the scenes and contributed outstanding service in support of the council's mission delivery to girl and adult members.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>	<p style="text-align: center;">Appreciation Pin</p> <p>The Appreciation Pin also recognizes an individual's exemplary service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, but for this pin the impact is within one geographic area of service, such as a Membership Area or community.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>
<p style="text-align: center;">Honor Pin</p> <p>The Honor Pin recognizes an individual's exemplary service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience; this support has had measurable impact on two or more geographic areas of service, such as multiple Membership Areas or communities, to reach and surpass the mission-delivery goals of the council.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>	<p style="text-align: center;">Thanks Badge I</p> <p>The Thanks Badge honors an individual whose ongoing commitment, leadership, and service have had an exceptional, measurable impact on meeting the mission-delivery goals and priorities of the entire council or the entire Girl Scout Movement.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>
<p style="text-align: center;">Thanks Badge II</p> <p>The Thanks Badge honors an individual whose ongoing commitment, leadership, and service have had an exceptional, measurable impact on meeting the mission-delivery goals and priorities of the entire council or the entire Girl Scout Movement.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>	<p style="text-align: center;">President's Award</p> <p>The President's Award recognizes the efforts of a team or committee whose exemplary service in support of delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience surpassed team goals and resulted in significant, measurable impact toward reaching the council's overall goals.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">   </div>

Nomination Process

1. To nominate someone, an online form needs to be completed and can be found on the Badgerland Council website at gsbadgerland.org or found here - <https://girlscoutsbadgerland.wufoo.com/forms/znc6p1t1c0sxj0/>
2. Anyone (fellow leader, parent, community member, etc.) may nominate a volunteer for an award. A separate nomination must be completed for each volunteer submitted.
3. Any currently registered Girl Scout volunteer in good standing with Badgerland Council can be nominated for an award regardless of the length of time they have been a volunteer.
4. This award represents the volunteer's work for the 2019-20 Membership Year (October 1, 2019- September 30, 2020).
5. Include specific information about the nominee's unique qualifications for the award.
6. Ask others to nominate the same volunteer that you feel is going above and beyond as a Girl Scout volunteer. Multiple nominations for the same volunteer help to elevate them in the award process.
